
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# About The Summit




### Sustainability Startathon: Country Rounds


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# **Sustainability Quest**

## Sustainability Startathon: Grand Finals

**The epic culmination of the Sustainability Startathon**, the Grand Finals are the ultimate test of entrepreneurship and sustainability for 180 youth delegates from across ASEAN, China and India—the best and brightest of the next generation of young Asian leaders in the region.

The first day includes speed mentoring sessions, which primes participating teams with a final round of advice given by industry experts.

Over the next two days, teams bring their collective knowledge and expertise—months of hard work and experience gathered over the course of four months—to bear in tackling their challenge statement(s), competing for the top prize of SGD10,000.

**The top 3 teams win** a collective cash prize pool of SGD18,000. They also receive up to 6 months of mentorship opportunities to further develop their sustainable solutions, as well as a chance to showcase them at next year's Summit.

All Country Rounds contestants and Grand Finalists are invited to join the ASEAN-China-India Youth Leadership Summit alumni community.
